



# TELPAS Alternate

## *Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System*

TELPAS Alternate is a holistic inventory aligned with the Texas English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS); however, TELPAS Alternate is based on alternate PLD's, which were created to address the specific needs of this student population. Like TELPAS, students assessed with TELPAS Alternate are assessed in four domains: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

TELPAS Alternate is not a traditional test where students answer multiple choice questions. Rather it is a holistic inventory that contains descriptions of behaviors, called observable behaviors, for test administrators to reflect on regarding each student's use of the English language, in each of the four domains.
