



# TELPAS

## *Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System*

The Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS) assesses the English language proficiency of English learners (ELs) in grades kindergarten through 12. Students are tested in four different domains: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Their performance is reported based on the four English proficiency levels: beginning, intermediate, advanced, and advanced high. The assessment components for grades K-1 and 2-12 include the following:

- Grades K-1
  - Holistically rated observational assessments of listening, speaking, reading, and writing.
- Grades 2-12
  - Multiple choice online reading tests in six grade clusters: 2, 3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9, and 10-12.
  - Online listening and speaking tests in four grade clusters: 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, and 9-12.
  - Holistically rated student writing collections
